## How to Disconnect from a Server or File Share

## Windows:

- 1. Open a command prompt by either:
  - Click Start > Programs > Accessories > Command prompt
    - or -
  - Click Start > Run and type "cmd" (without the quotes) and click OK
- 2. Type " net use " and press enter to view your active SMB connections.
- 3. Type " net use /delete \\servername\\sharename " and press enter. (Where "servername\\sharename" is the name of the server and share point to which you are connected.)
  - For example: " net use /delete \\mlmlapps\\windows "
- 4. Type " net use " again to verify that the desired connection has been deleted.
